**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE TOWN OF GRANBY
PUBLIC WORKS MANUAL BY REFERENCE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Granby, Colorado, pursuant to Colorado statute is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Granby, Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it in the best interest of the Town to adopt and provide uniform standards for design and construction of infrastructure including roads, water and sewer facilities, drainage conveyance structures, and other municipal infrastructure and appurtenances for new development and redevelopment within the Town of Granby; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this goal, the Board requested its engineer Schmueser Gordon Meyer (“SGM”), draft a Public Works Manual; and

WHEREAS, the Board reviewed the Town of Granby Public Works Manual and at its regular meeting on February 25, 2020, listened to public comment to the extent provided; and

WHEREAS, notice of such hearing was provided as required pursuant to section 31-16-203, Colorado Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, copies of the primary code, the Town of Granby Public Works Manual, and all secondary codes referenced therein have been on file with the Town Clerk and open to inspection as required by section 31-16-203, Colorado Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Granby to adopt the Town of Granby Public Works Manual and codify its enforcement.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF GRANBY AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Granby Public Works Manual is hereby approved and adopted by reference as Chapter 15.05.140 of the Granby Town Code as set forth below:

15.05.140 Town of Granby Public Works Manual

- (a) The Town of Granby Public Works Manual for the design and construction of public improvements (hereinafter referred to as “manual”) published in 2019, as promulgated by the Town of Granby, Zero Jasper Avenue, Granby Colorado 80446, is hereby adopted and enacted by reference. The purpose of this manual is to codify the public works standards and specifications of the Town which are of a general and permanent nature to regulate and maintain consistency in development and redevelopment of the public improvements and common facilities.
 - (b) Minor modifications. In an effort to keep the manual up-to-date with current standards and specifications, minor modifications as described below may be approved by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Granby by resolution. A “minor modification” is defined as changing a reference to a secondary code, updating terms, updating standard measurements, correcting typographical errors, and any other matter that does not materially change the intent and purpose of the manual and does not lessen the public health, safety and welfare requirements. The minor modifications shall be made in writing.
 - (c) Severability. If any section, subsection or provision of the manual herein adopted, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances, is declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid by any competent court with jurisdiction on the matter, such invalidity shall not affect the other sections, subsections, provisions or application of the manual if such may be given effect without the invalid section, subsection, provision or application.
 - (d) At least two (2) copies of the Town of Granby Public Works Manual, certified by the Town Clerk to be a true copy of such manual as adopted by this section and amended from time to time shall be kept on file in the office of the Town Clerk and made available for public inspection.
 - (e) Sale of manual copies. The Town Clerk shall maintain a reasonable supply of copies of the Town of Granby Public Works Manual to be available for purchase by the public at a moderate price.
2. Validity. If any part of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have approved this ordinance and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

3. Repeal. Existing ordinances or parts of ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent collection of any impact fees incurred of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.
