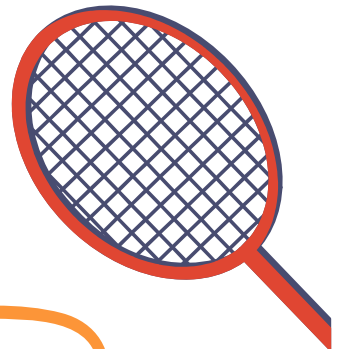
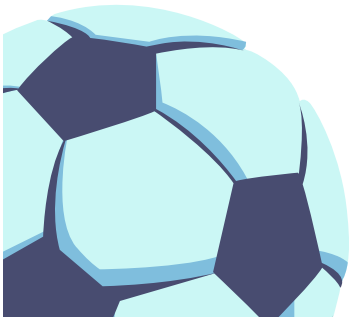

Prerequisites: Must be at least 14 years old and hold current Adult CPR/AED certification. Topics covered include: Primary and Secondary Assessments, Head/Brain, Neck and Spinal Injuries, Heat-Related Emergencies, Hypothermia, Altitude-Related Illnesses, Allergies and Anaphylaxis, Burns, Bone and Joint Injuries, Wounds and Wound Infection. Course length: 16 hours. Please register by Thursday, May 22.

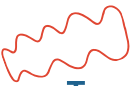

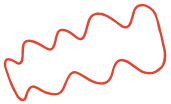
