Responsible Alcohol Service Training



Completion of the Responsible Alcohol Service Training class will satisfy the State of Colorado requirements for alcohol server training. It is strongly encouraged for management, all retail employees, and alcohol servers (i.e. bartenders and wait staff) to attend this class every year to reduce your liabilities. Those that participate in alcohol tastings at off-premise locations are required by the State of Colorado to take this class every three years.

IDVisor® Z22 Mobile ID Scanner is a handheld ID scanner, used to quickly check patron's age and record valuable transaction data. The ID Scanner reads magnetic stripes and 2D bar codes on licenses from 50 states (GA from 11/2009), all Canadian provinces (Quebec from 2/2009) and most Military IDs. The scanner is simple to operate - just scan or swipe licenses and it will display updates.
