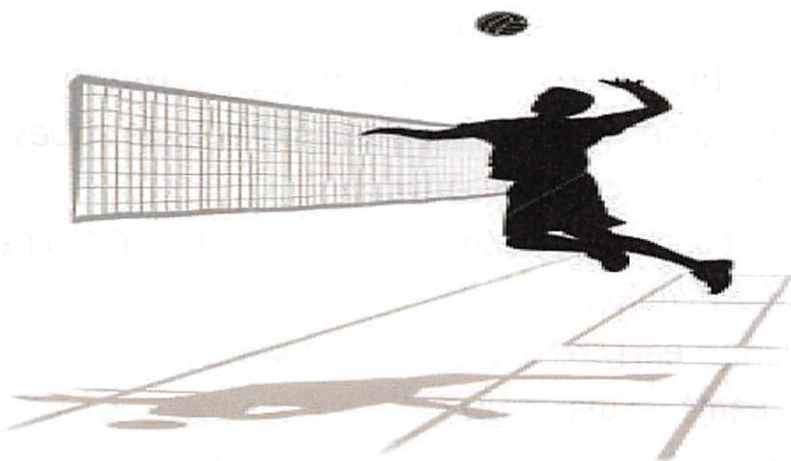


# High Altitude Volleyball Challenge!

## Tournament Rules:

We follow the current Colorado High School Association Volleyball rules with the following additions/clarifications:

1. All games will be played on a men's net height.
2. Players must be 18 years or older to play (exceptions made on a case by case basis by contacting Tournament Dir., Jess Kennedy, 970-887-3961.
3. A six or five-person team must consist of at least 2 women on the court at all times, if only one woman is present, a team is permitted to play with one woman and two men, making a total of three players. Any team with less than three players is a forfeit.
4. All games will be self-refereed. Any debated play/call will result in a replay.
5. All players must change into their volleyball shoes immediately upon entering the Granby Soccer Dome. You may not wear the same shoes to the Dome that you plan to wear on the court.
6. All games will be rally scored to 25 (must win by 2), best 2 out of 3. The 3<sup>rd</sup> game (if needed) will be to 15 (win by 2).
7. If the 7:00 PM game is finished early, the teams must vacate the court by 7:50 PM to allow other teams to warm up.
8. All participants must sign a roster prior to playing their first game. Rosters must be turned in at the first tourney game on April 11, 2023. Rostered players may not play for another team.
9. No food or drinks (except water) are allowed in the dome.
10. Good sportsmanship is expected to be displayed at all times!
11. In the event of a pool play tie, the tie breaker will be total points scored for each team. If there is still a tie, the winner will be determined by a flip of a coin.
